LITERACY

The children learned the letter and sound M,m and D,d these past two weeks. They are doing well with writing letters and finding the words with the letter of the week. However, a little practice at home won't hurt. They like doing it at school so I guess they'll be eager to show you their writing skills at home. Our show and tell routine is getting more challenging each time with the children asking and answering more detailed questions such as - Why did you take this item for show tell? Where did you get it from? etc. With letters D and M we have started the 3rd group of letters in Jolly Phonics. We'll learn G next week and we'll do a review after that.

MATH

Math is becoming very popular in our classroom. The children learned and practised counting and writing down numbers 0 to 20 last week. We did a shapes review and learned more difficult shapes such as pentagon, hexagon, & octagon. Next, we introduced simple addition to the children, many of them were familiar with the topic already. What a bunch of fast and eager learners we have!

SCIENCE
