What we are learning:

Language:

We learned 4 letter sounds- S, A, T, and I. We practiced the action, holding a pencil correctly, correct letter formation and identifying words that start with these sounds. We also started to blend 2-3 sounds together to make words.

Math:

We have been focusing on number sense through the "number of the day." Count Dracula from Sesame Street tells us the number of the day so we can practice formation and the different ways to show the number. We can count objects, dots on a dice, tally marks, fingers or dots in a 10-frame.

We have also been counting our days in school and just completed our 15th day in school. This is being taught through tens and ones place value blocks.

Theme:

All About Me

We decorated our CPK Birthday display with a lesson on calendars. We drew our back to school self portrait for our Portfolios and discussed hand washing in an effort to stay healthy! Through a science experiment and a lot of glitter we showed the importance of washing our hands thoroughly.

Friendship

We talked a lot about friendship and what makes a good friend. For Art, we made paper dolls and a friendship chain to show how we all need to work together to be kind and good friends in our classroom. We finished the week exploring the different ways to share with a group.
